THE STATE BOTANICAL GARDENS

Less formal programs, such as Garden Rambles, provide relaxing walks through the garden and focus on specific items of seasonal interest.



GEORGIA THEATRE

The Georgia Theatre was originally the home of the Athens YMCA from 1889 to 1919. After that, it was used for an array of different businesses, including a hotel, music store, and a furniture company. The Georgia Theatre now hosts a variety of bands and events, and its iconic sign has been used by many for pictures and proposals.

ATHFEST

AthFest is a three-day, family-friendly music festival in Athens that supports music and arts education by supporting their nonprofit AthFest Educates. It brings local and regional musicians and artists to venues throughout Downtown Athens, appealing to a broad audience. There also is a designated block-long area of the festival for children.



UGA FOOTBALL

One of the best ways to experience Athens is by coming to a UGA football game. The whole dynamic of the city changes during football season, and you will see families and college students tailgating all over campus and its surrounding areas all day long on Saturdays. Sanford Stadium, which has been recently renovated, is one of the most iconic places in Athens. It sits directly in the middle of UGA's campus and has the capacity to hold 92,746 people. It is famous for the hedges that surround the field and is widely known as the greatest spectator stadium in the South.
